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EnKA[©] Certification Application Requirements

Certification requires that your hours of training in Energy Kinesiology be verified by the Certification and Accreditation Board (CAB). There are three levels of certification available as listed below. All certified levels are required to read, sign and return the Code of Ethics.

Certified Energy Kinesiologist Level 1, CeNK¹, demonstrates a foundation in the basic principles of Kinesiology and demonstrates, via the 'stream,' the beginning of specialization. 250 Kinesiology hours + 8 hours Ethics + First Aid Certification

- 100 hours of Category A courses
- 75 hours minimum of Category B Accredited classes which are 'streams' from your Category A classes
- 75 hours of other Category A, B, or Elective courses, repeats or conference attendance
- 8 hours of EnKA[®] Ethics 1
- First Aid or CPR certification

Certified Energy Kinesiologist Level 2, CeNK², demonstrates a deepening of education both in Kinesiology and related studies. In addition to classes taken for Level 1, an additional 250 hours of Kinesiology training plus 220 hours of related classes are required. All approved hours of Level 1 apply towards requirements for Level 2, for a total of 500 Kinesiology and 220 other class hours. If you are applying for the first time at Level 2, submit all documentation for Levels 1 and 2. If you are already Certified Level 1, submit documentation for:

- 125 hours minimum additional hours in Category B Accredited classes which are 'streams' from your Category A classes
- 125 minimum additional hours in other Category A, or Category B or Elective classes, repeats or conference attendance
- 8 hours of EnKA® Ethics 2
- Current First Aid or CPR certification
- Clarification is detailed in Appendix 9

In addition to Kinesiology hours, Certified Energy Kinesiologist Level 2 requires class hours in these subjects:

•	Anatomy & Physiology	100 hrs of EnKA CAB approved courses
•	Nutrition	40 hrs of EnKA® CAB approved courses
•	Communication/Interactions	40 hrs of EnKA [®] CAB approved courses
•	Business Management	40 hrs of EnKA® CAB approved courses

Certified Energy Kinesiologist Level 3, CeNK³, demonstrates a broad range of education in a variety of Kinesiology disciplines. In addition to classes taken for Levels 1 and 2, an additional 500 hours of Kinesiology training plus 50 hours of Anatomy & Physiology are required. All previously approved hours apply towards requirements for Level 3, for a total of 1000 Kinesiology and 274 other class hours. If you are applying for the first time at Level 3, submit all documentation for Levels 1, 2 and 3. If you are already Certified Level 2, submit documentation for:

- An additional 500 hours of EnKA[®]CAB accredited training * (Total of 100 hours Level A, 300 level B, 600 A, B or Elective)
- An additional 50 hours Anatomy & Physiology (Total of 150 hours A & P)
- 4 hours CAB[©] Ethics 3
- First Aid or CPR current certification

*up to 200 hours of repeat coursework may be logged for credit.

Additional Information

- Anatomy and Physiology (A&P), Nutrition, Communication and Business courses must be from an approved school, **and/or** an approved EnKA [®]CAB course.
- A portion of the A&P hours may be from an online course such as the University of Phoenix, to be approved by CAB. *Please contact your CAB representative*.
- Please include copies of your transcripts.
- All 3 Ethics courses are required and strongly recommended.
- Please include a copy of your Ethics certificate of completion.
- If you are already certified as a level I or 2 Professional and you are applying to advance your standing, you need only include the additional requirements and let us know that you are already a level 1 or 2 professional in your application package.
- Please note: Since Ethics is currently only taught at Conference, we will waive your Ethics requirement for one year if you intend to take it at the next conference. Don't wait to certify!
- First Aid or CPR courses can be taken locally, and we advise you to stay current.
- The Business Management requirement may be waived, if the applicant can demonstrate practical business experience. *Please contact your CAB representative*.
